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Study Aids Descriptions

Multistate Bar Examination (MBE)

MBE–OPE 1. The Multistate Bar Examination Online Practice Exam 1 (MBE–OPE 1, 2006, revised 2014) is a 100-question, annotated practice exam that uses questions drawn from actual MBEs administered in previous years. (The questions have been retired and will not appear on a future MBE.) The annotations explain why each answer choice is correct or incorrect. Six MBE subject areas: Constitutional Law, Contracts, Criminal Law and Procedure, Evidence, Real Property, and Torts. NOTE: MBE–OPE 1 does not include Civil Procedure, which was introduced as a subject area in February 2015.

MBE–OPE 2. The Multistate Bar Examination Online Practice Exam 2 (MBE–OPE 2, 2009, revised 2014) is a 100-question, annotated practice exam that uses questions drawn from actual MBEs administered in previous years. (The questions have been retired and will not appear on a future MBE.) The annotations explain why each answer choice is correct or incorrect. This OPE is identical in format to the MBE–OPE 1 but contains a different set of 100 questions. Six MBE subject areas: Constitutional Law, Contracts, Criminal Law and Procedure, Evidence, Real Property, and Torts. NOTE: MBE–OPE 2 does not include Civil Procedure, which was introduced as a subject area in February 2015.

MBE–OPE 3. The Multistate Bar Examination Online Practice Exam 3 (MBE–OPE 3, 2011, revised 2017) is a 100-question, annotated practice exam that uses questions drawn from actual MBEs administered in previous years. (The questions have been retired and will not appear on a future MBE.) The annotations explain why each answer choice is correct or incorrect. This OPE is identical in format to the MBE–OPE 1 and 2 but contains a different set of 100 questions. Six MBE subject areas: Constitutional Law, Contracts, Criminal Law and Procedure, Evidence, Real Property, and Torts. NOTE: MBE–OPE 3 does not include Civil Procedure, which was introduced as a subject area in February 2015.

MBE–OPE 4. The Multistate Bar Examination Online Practice Exam 4 (MBE–OPE 4, 2013, revised 2017) is a 100-question, annotated practice exam that uses questions drawn from actual MBEs administered in previous years. (The questions have been retired and will not appear on a future MBE.) The annotations explain why each answer choice is correct or incorrect. This OPE is identical in format to the MBE–OPE 1, 2, and 3 but contains a different set of 100 questions. Six MBE subject areas: Constitutional Law, Contracts, Criminal Law and Procedure, Evidence, Real Property, and Torts. NOTE: MBE–OPE 4 does not include Civil Procedure, which was introduced as a subject area in February 2015.

Civil Procedure Sample Test Questions. These 26 sample questions are intended to familiarize candidates with Civil Procedure MBE-style questions. While these sample questions illustrate the kinds of Civil Procedure questions on the MBE, they do not represent all the Civil Procedure material that will be covered. The key to these sample questions follows the questions themselves. After the key, you will find annotations to each question that explain why each answer is correct or incorrect.

Civil Procedure Study Aid (2019). Consists of 30 annotated Civil Procedure items. The annotations explain why each answer choice is correct or incorrect. These

items are also published in the MBE Study Aid (2019), but without annotations.

MBE Study Aid (Released 2017/Updated 2019). Contains 210 questions drawn from previous MBEs, with 30 questions for each of the seven MBE subject areas (Civil Procedure is included). Questions are grouped by subject; each group of questions is prefaced by the relevant section of the Subject Matter Outline and followed by an answer key. These items do not include detailed annotations like our MBE–OPE items.

MBE Complete Practice Exam. The Multistate Bar Examination Complete Practice Exam (2021) is a 200-question, annotated practice exam that uses questions drawn from actual MBEs administered in recent years. (The questions have been retired and will not appear on a future MBE.) The annotations explain why each answer choice is correct or incorrect. All seven MBE subject areas are represented just like an actual MBE exam. This is the only set of MBE materials offered by NCBE that covers all seven subject matters AND includes answer annotations.

Multistate Essay Examination (MEE)

MEE Questions and Analyses. Contains the MEE questions given in February or July of a given year and includes model analyses that are illustrative of the discussions that might appear in excellent answers to the questions. The subjects covered by each question are listed on the first page of its accompanying analysis, identified by roman numerals that refer to the MEE subject matter outline for each subject. For example, the Constitutional Law question on the February 2015 MEE tested the following areas from the Constitutional Law outline: II.A.3., The separation of powers—The powers of Congress—Power to enforce the 13th, 14th, and 15th Amendments; and IV.C., Individual rights—Equal protection.

Multistate Performance Test (MPT)

MPTs and Point Sheets. Contains the MPTs given in February or July of a given year and includes corresponding point sheets. The MPT point sheets describe the factual and legal points encompassed within the lawyering tasks

to be completed. They outline the possible issues and points that might be addressed by an examinee. They are provided to the user jurisdictions to assist graders in grading the examination by identifying the issues and suggesting the resolution of the problems contemplated by the drafters.

Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE)

MPRE–OPE 1. The Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination Online Practice Exam 1 (MPRE–OPE 1, 2009) is a 60-question, annotated practice exam that uses questions drawn from actual MPREs administered in recent years. (The questions have been retired and will not appear on a future MPRE.) The annotations by the experts who write questions for the MPRE explain why each answer choice is correct or incorrect.

MPRE–OPE 2. The Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination Online Practice Exam 2 (MPRE–OPE 2, 2017) is a 60-question, annotated practice exam that uses questions drawn from actual MPREs administered in recent years. (The questions have been retired and will not appear on a future MPRE.) The annotations by the experts who write questions for the MPRE explain why each answer choice is correct or incorrect.

MPRE Sample Test Questions 2021. These 33 annotated questions were developed by updating questions administered on recent MPREs. (The questions have been retired and will not appear on a future MPRE.) The annotations by the experts who write questions for the MPRE explain why each answer choice is correct or incorrect. The 33 questions cover 11 out of 12 topics included in the MPRE Subject Matter Outline (only specification IX—regarding safekeeping funds and other property—is not covered).

MPRE–3. The Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination 3 (MPRE 3, 2025) is a 60-question, annotated practice exam that uses questions drawn from actual MPREs administered in recent years. (The questions are retired and will not appear on a future MPRE.) The annotations by the experts who write questions for the MPRE explain by each answer choice is correct or incorrect.

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
